Objectives of Equal Opportunity Cell (EOC)

1. ENSURE NON-DISCRIMINATION

To prevent discrimination and harassment on the basis of caste, religion, ethnicity, gender, disability, or socio-economic background within higher education institutions (HEIs).

2. PROMOTE EQUAL ACCESS AND OPPORTUNITY

To ensure that students and staff from marginalized sections, SC/ST/OBC/Minorities/Persons with Disabilities/SEDGs) have equal access to academic resources, opportunities, and infrastructure.

3. SUPPORT DISADVANTAGED GROUPS

To provide academic, financial, psychological, and social support to students from disadvantaged and under-represented communities.

4. CREATE AWARENESS OF RIGHTS AND DUTIES

To spread awareness among students and faculty about constitutional provisions related to equality, social justice, and inclusive education.

5. FACILITATE INCLUSIVE POLICIES

To assist in the formulation and implementation of policies and practices that promote diversity, equity, and inclusion across the campus.

6. MONITOR EQUITY PRACTICES

To oversee the effective implementation of reservation policies and inclusive practices in admissions, recruitment, accommodation, scholarships, and other institutional programs.

PROVIDE REDRESSAL MECHANISM

To offer a prompt and transparent grievance Redressal system for complaints related to discrimination or denial of rights.

7. PROMOTE CAPACITY BUILDING

To conduct workshops, training programs, bridge courses, and counseling sessions to empower students from marginalized groups.

8. ENCOURAGE INCLUSIVE PARTICIPATION

To ensure representation of all communities in decision-making bodies, student councils, and cultural/academic events.

9. BUILD AN INCLUSIVE CAMPUS CULTURE

To cultivate an environment that fosters mutual respect, empathy, dignity, and equal opportunity for all members of the academic community.
